Workforce Solutions M&A Review



Introduction

Although the Workforce Solutions M&A market was significantly impacted by the global pandemic in 2020, with transaction volumes falling by around 60% from their 2019 levels, the market was also one of the quickest to recover. In 2022, we saw a record of 341 completed M&A transactions in the sector.

Three main factors contributed to the surge in transactions in 2022:

- Sellers targeting an exit in 2020 were forced to delay their plans and ultimately transacted in 2022.
- The dramatic surge in revenues and profits resulting from client demand as companies rebuilt their workforce following the pandemic resulted in many workforce solutions companies reporting record profits in 2021. This caused many sellers to choose 2022 as a year to seek a transaction while at the same time, buyers felt confident to acquire on the back of their strong performance.
- Persistent skills shortages and low unemployment point to favourable long-term prospects for the industry, even when factoring in the expectation of slower economic growth during high inflation and increasing interest rates which started to impact from the second half of the year.

This report presents a more detailed analysis of the M&A activity in the sector over the past 18 months.



Long-term prospects for M&A in the Workforce Solutions sector remain strong, though we anticipate 2023 deal volumes will fall short of the record set in 2022.

Impact of conversational AI

One of the main drivers behind adopting conversational AI, which focuses on simulating human-like conversations through chatbots and virtual assistants, is its ability to provide round-theclock engagement with candidates. In the recruitment domain, conversational AI platforms have become invaluable tools for automating tasks, delivering personalised experiences for candidates, and improving overall recruitment efficiency.

These platforms can generate recruitment marketing content, answer routine questions from candidates, conduct initial screening interviews, and assist recruiters by generating contextualised content for their communications with candidates. By automating repetitive tasks and leveraging AI-driven analytics, recruiters can focus on strategic decision-making and building meaningful connections with candidates.

With new products already on the market from *SeekOut*, *Beamery* and others, Workforce Solutions firms must keep pace with the advances by leveraging these technologies in their businesses to remain competitive.

Talent marketplaces gaining market share

Talent marketplaces have emerged as a transformative force in the employment landscape, disrupting traditional hiring and job placement models. These platforms leverage AI and advanced algorithms to connect companies with talent across the globe at scale.

Rather than rely on candidates applying to specific job openings, Talent marketplaces present companies with pre-screened candidates ranked based on fit. This process helps to find candidates who may not have applied for roles they are well-suited for but do not meet all of the stated qualifications. Many platforms are designed to reduce the impact of unconscious bias in the hiring process, thereby increasing diversity and the overall pool of available talent.

JobandTalent, which achieved unicorn status in 2021, has led the way in the commercial and industrial sectors by acquiring many traditional staffing and recruitment firms and migrating these businesses to the marketplace model. Newer to the scene is *Workgenius* which focuses on the professional sectors and has completed two transactions since June 2022.



We expect increasing cross-over between technology-led and services-led firms in the Workforce Solutions M&A market.

M&A | DEALS SNAPSHOT



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- Circle8Group expanded its geographic reach with two acquisitions in the first half of 2023.
- In June, it secured a majority stake in Königstein, one of Germany's leading IT staffing and solutions providers, which follows its March acquisition of Swiss IT staffing and consulting firm Swisslinx.
- Königstein uses its own employees and freelancers to support the implementation of customised IT solutions.
- The existing management team and employees of Königstein will remain and it will also continue to operate under the existing brand.
- Swisslinx, is a market leader for placements of IT professionals into the Swiss financial services industry.
- Swisslinx will also maintain its brand identity and continue to operate independently but within the Circle8Group's umbrella.
- Both acquisitions emphasize Circle8Group's aggressive expansion strategy and commitment to strengthening its position in the European IT staffing and solutions market following the majority investment by Axiom Partners in April 2021.
- Circle8 was formerly known as De Staffing Group before rebranding earlier this year.
- · Financial details were not disclosed for either transaction.

- In the first quarter of 2023, House of HR continued its ambitious acquisition plan by acquiring Pluss, a German company specializing in healthcare and social services temporary staffing.
- Founded in 1984, Pluss provides staffing solutions for roles such as nurses, physicians, and other health professionals.
- The company reported revenues of €157m in 2022.
- Currently, the company employs around 470 people from 48 locations across Germany, with plans to expand to 55 locations this year with the support of House of HR.
- The acquisition is House of HR's third in the German healthcare staffing solutions sector, following the previous acquisitions of Avanti in 2021 and LD Personalvermittlung in 2022. These acquisitions are expected to generate synergies and facilitate collective expansion.
- Post-acquisition, Pluss' existing management, including Managing Directors Christian Baumann and Wolfgang Ungerathen, will remain in place and will retain its brand.
- Bain Capital acquired a 55% stake in House of HR in November 2022.

TRANSACTION ACTIVITY | OVERVIEW

M&A Overview

Merger and Acquisition (M&A) activity within the staffing sector reached unprecedented heights in the year 2022, with a total of 341 transactions announced publicly across the globe. Macroeconomic factors have caused the market to cool in the second guarter of 2023, though activity was within the norms of pre-pandemic activity levels. In total, we analysed 491 workforce solutions transactions over the past six quarters in this report.

Targets from the non-specialist Commercial Staffing (99 transactions, 20%) and Professional Staffing (77 transactions, 16%) subsectors represented the highest proportion of overall transactions. Within the specialist subsectors, Healthcare and IT Staffing were most common, with 64 (13%) and 63 (13%) transactions, respectively.

Geographically, North America, predominantly the US, exhibited the highest M&A activity, accounting for 240 (49%) of buyers and 224 (46%) of targets. Europe followed closely, securing the second position with a share of 42% for both buyers and targets. Targets from the United Kingdom and the Netherlands were the most sought-after in Europe, with 75 and 59 completed deals, respectively. The Asia-Pacific region represented a share of 7% for buyers and 10% for targets. Nearly three-quarters of all reported transactions were domestic, where the buyer and target were headquartered in the same country, with 27% classified as cross-border.

Strategic Buyers accounted for the vast majority (93%) of all M&A transactions in the period. The Strategic Buyer category includes buyers that are PE-backed, as well as listed businesses and other privately-held companies.

As is customary for private M&A transactions, most deal terms were not disclosed. For the small sample of transactions with disclosed transaction metrics, the average EBITDA multiple reported was 5.6x. Listed companies in the sector are currently trading at an average EV/EBITDA multiple of 7.6x.

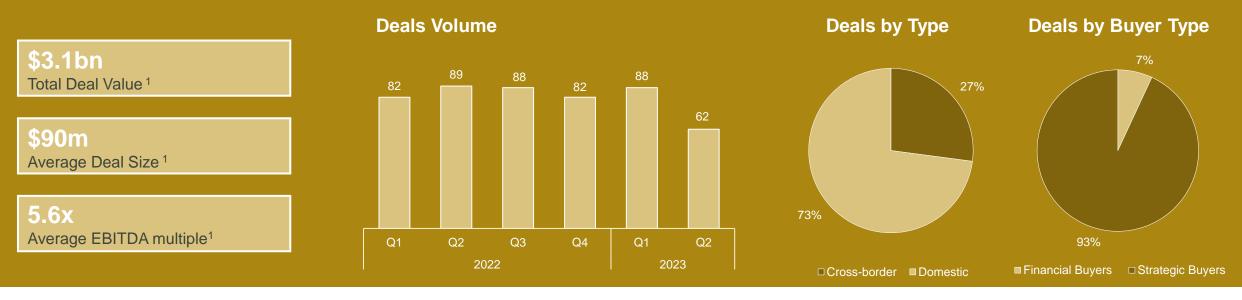

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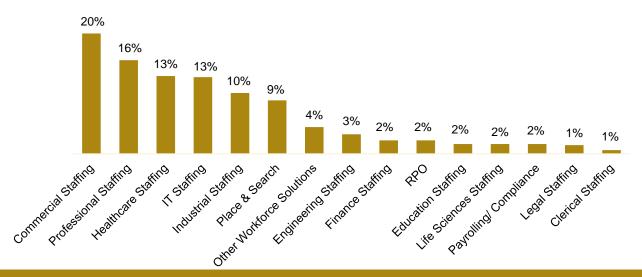
